The line-up of Spellbound this month was Grahame Taylor piano, Doug Kuhn bass, Howard Rowe drums and Barrie Boyes sax. They completed the night's entertainment with: 

☐ Out of Nowhere - a Johnny Green song with lyrics by Edward Heyman, recorded in 1931 by Bing Crosby and it became his No 1 hit song as a solo artist. 
# The New Normal (and other already hackneyed phrases)


